The "Tackling Life" Youth Rugby Programme aims to help disadvantaged young people from schools of Po Leung Kuk build confidence and self-esteem.

Three Po Leung Kuk primary schools from Tuen Mun, a Po Leung Kuk Children's Learning Centre and a Language Training Programme have already joined this initiative, which uses experienced coaches from the Hong Kong Rugby Football Union to introduce the students to rugby as a medium to encourage a healthy and positive lifestyle. The programme will focus on building confidence and self-esteem, as well as developing students' team work and interpersonal skills.

Mr. Simon Hempel, Former Hong Kong Rugby Player from Macquarie Group said "Tackling Life is a great opportunity to teach Po Leung Kuk students some of the basics of rugby but more importantly develop valuable skills and qualities that the kids can draw upon in everyday life. From my experience rugby can be a great way to learn about friendship, hard work, perseverance and general health and well-being and hopefully the kids will learn the same from our time together."
